The Housing Trust prides itself on the quality of housing it offers to renters in the Rutland County Community. To maintain the quality housing the organization spends 30% of its revenue on property maintenance. This includes: grounds upkeep, elevators, painting, repairs, flooring, cleaning, equipment, plumbing and heating; and sprinkers and fire alarms.
